When Cooper was preparing for the trial - he came to my cell in county jail and bragged to me about his lengthy professional experience and about his \$25,000 retainers and \$11,000 a day trial fee. He also said this to me: "Sirhan, for you to tell me that you did not shoot & kill Kennedy, is like showing a red hot poker up your ass and you telling me that you don't feel any pain."

Cooper was not ready for trial - He wanted a plea bargain - that is why the prosecution got away with so much - and that is why ~~Cooper~~ Cooper was so ineffective as defense counsel - he did not, nor was he alert to discrepancies in ballistics etc in sum - I got shafted by everyone -

The above is Sirhan's handwritten response to my question about Cooper's pressuring Sirhan to plea bargain and NOT have a trial. Cooper didn't want to listen to what Sirhan had to say. (Adel obtained this note this past Feb 14 '93 when he spent almost six hours visiting with his brother). Sirhan asked Adel to give this statement to me.

② As to the 1985 interview with the L.A. Times reporter, I said what I said because it was literally inculcated into me that I was the only person who killed Bobby Kennedy. But, when the LAPD released the files of my case to the State Archives in 1988 (?), and I began to hear ~~that~~ from other inmates who watched T.V. programs, that I could not have committed the crime, and later when Lynn Morgan began to delve into the records at the Archives in Sacramento, I began to question my involvement in this horrible crime. I asked Attorney Luke McKissick who represented me at an automatic appeal and at parole hearings about investigation possibility of my innocence, he scoffed at and told me that my case is open & shut and that my conviction was "unassailable."
